#### Neighbourhood Policing Panel Priorities

The Neighbourhood Policing Panel Priorities for the Bassingbourn and Melbourn part of the Sawston Neighbourhood that were set on the 20<sup>th</sup> October 09 for period to 19<sup>th</sup> January 09 were:

- In liaison with British Transport Police, reduce crime and anti-social behaviour linked to the railway stations at Ashwell, Foxton and Shepreth. Includes vandalism, thefts and anti-social parking.
- Continue with the ASB reduction plan in place at High Street, The Moor and Vicarage Close, Melbourne.
- Reduce ASB in the Shepreth village.

#### Police Enhancement Access Line

Cambridge Police have now launched a dedicated phone number for people with communication difficulties. The police enhancement access line (PEAL) is available 24 hours a day for non-emergency calls for anyone who has a communication difficulty.

Those wanting to use the system must register first to ensure their details are already in the system. They will then be given the dedicated number which will allow them to contact a specially trained call taker. The scheme can be used for all non-emergency calls.
